The Operations Manager will oversee the day-to-day operations of the museum which include supervising staff, volunteers, associates, and vendors, processing purchasing and other financial transactions, managing social media and advertising, and organizing of special events and programs. Key competencies of this role are providing excellent and effective communication to the Executive Director, Board of Directors, guests, families, children, vendors, and community members. Operations Manager builds and cultivates partnerships which benefit the children of Merced County and the adults who care for them and works closely with all of the museum stakeholders to ensure financial stability and the immediate and long-term viability of Kids Discovery Station. Operations Manager plays an integral role in the administrative, facility and fiscal operations of the Museum.

- High school diploma or GED is required; a Bachelor's degree is preferred
- Must have strong leadership skills and be proactive
- Excellent time management skills and ability to organize a daily workload by priorities
